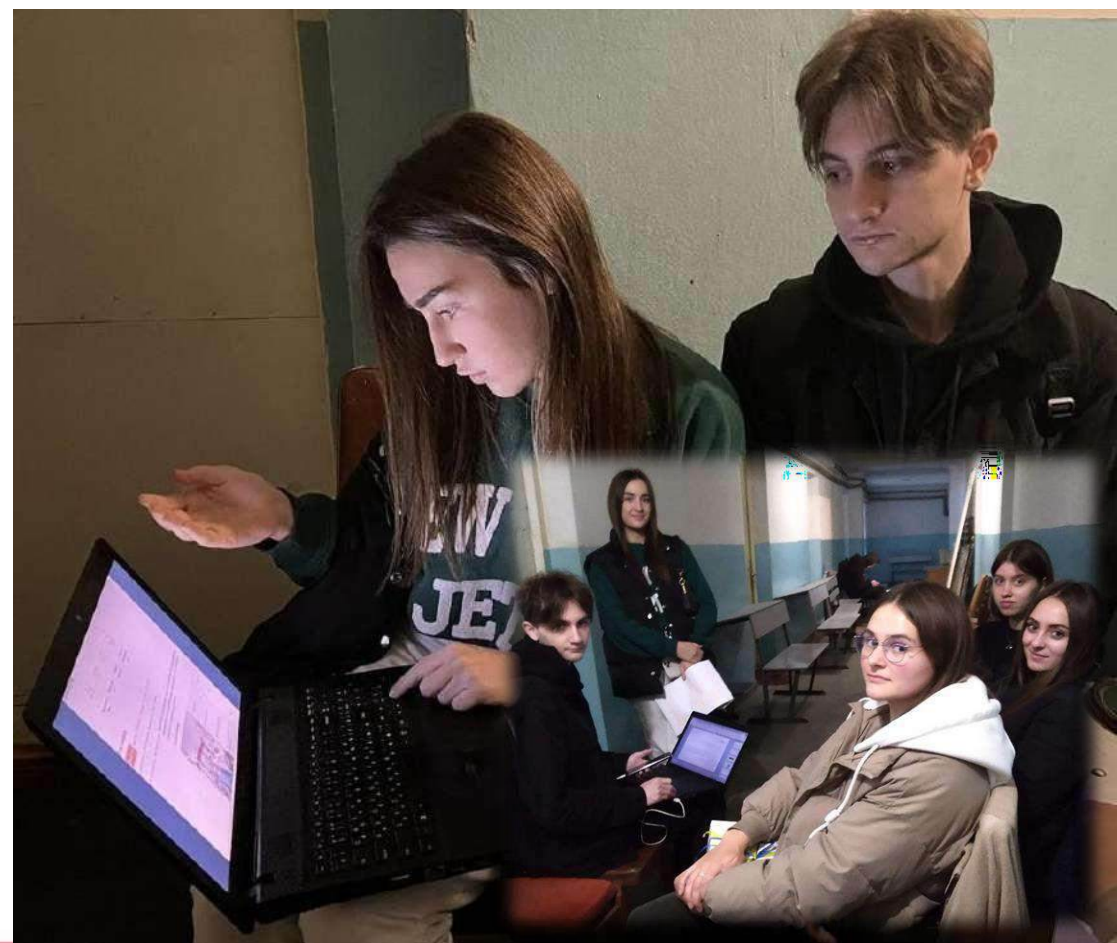

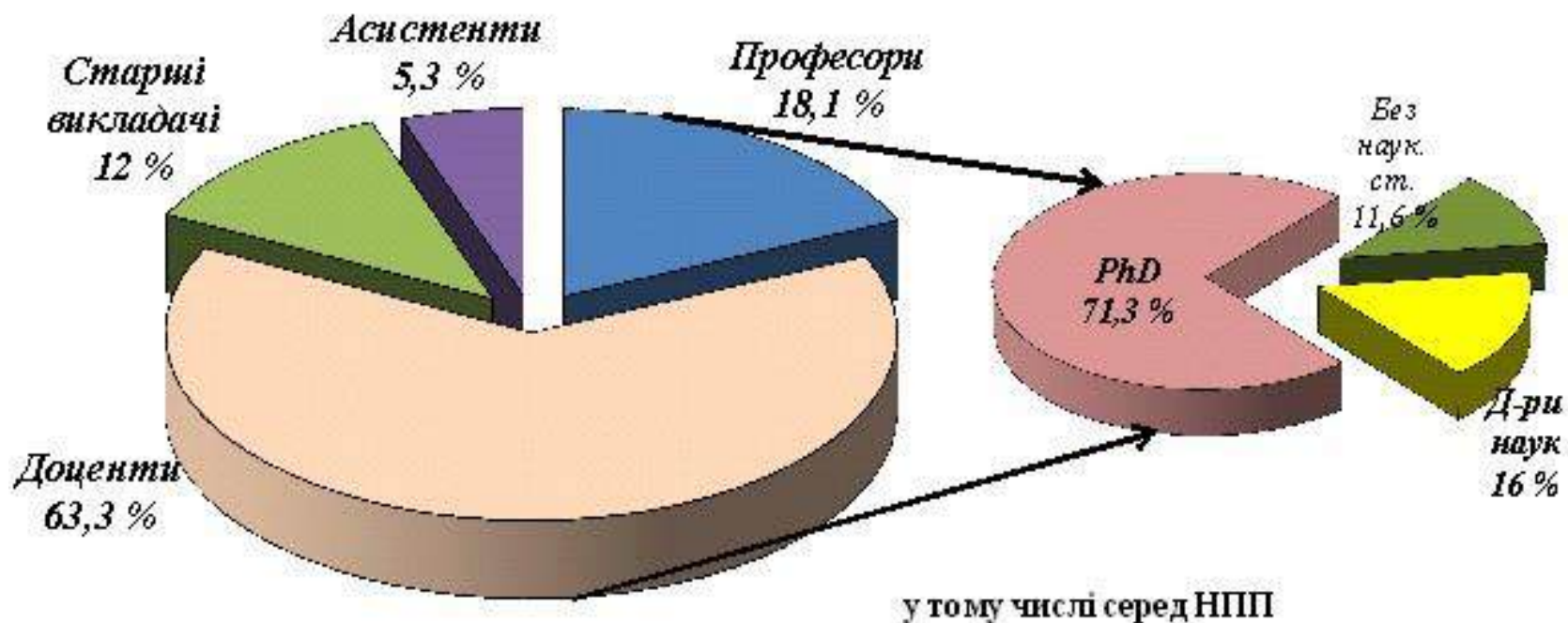

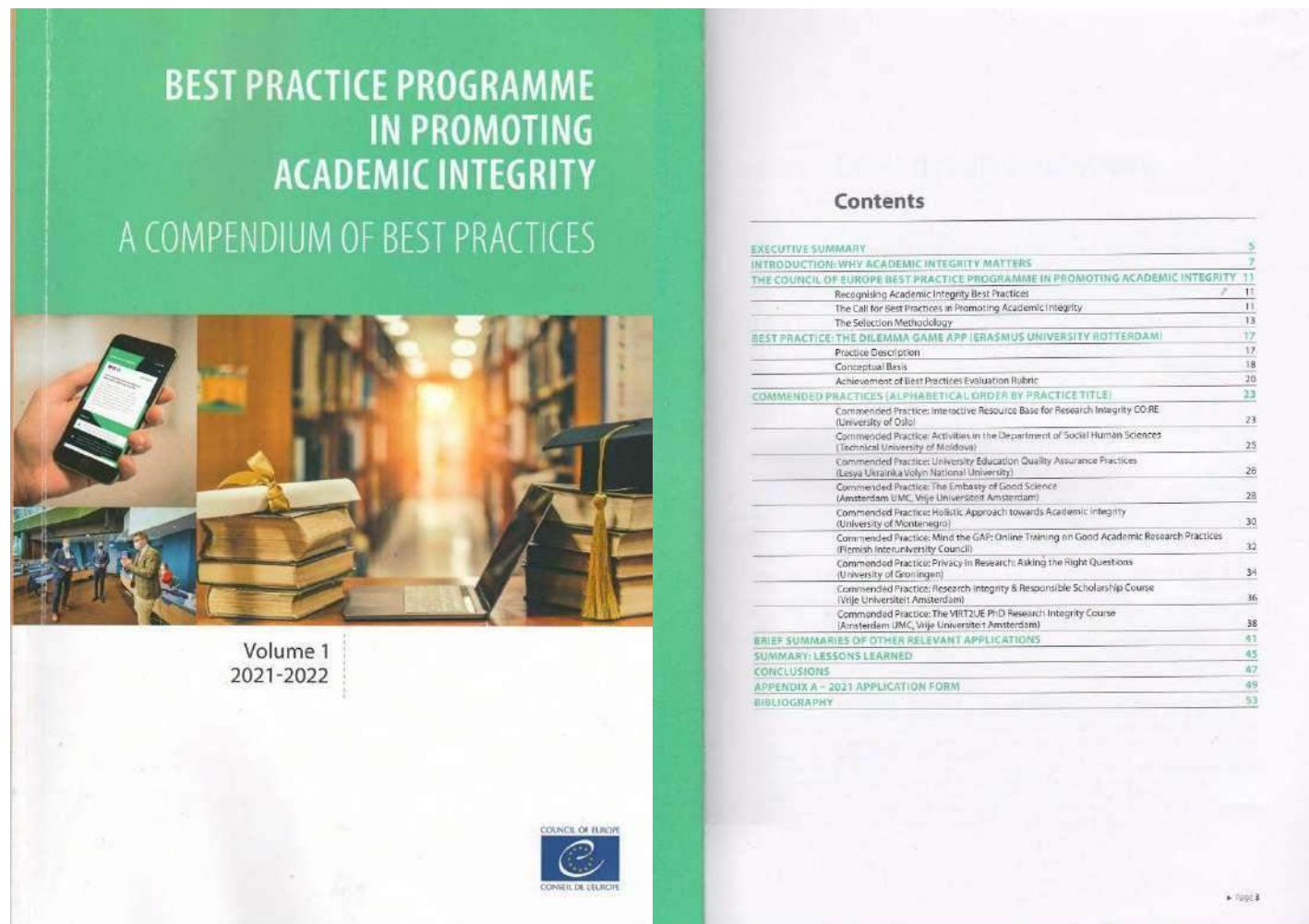
Signing of the Magna Carta of Universities in Bologna, Italy

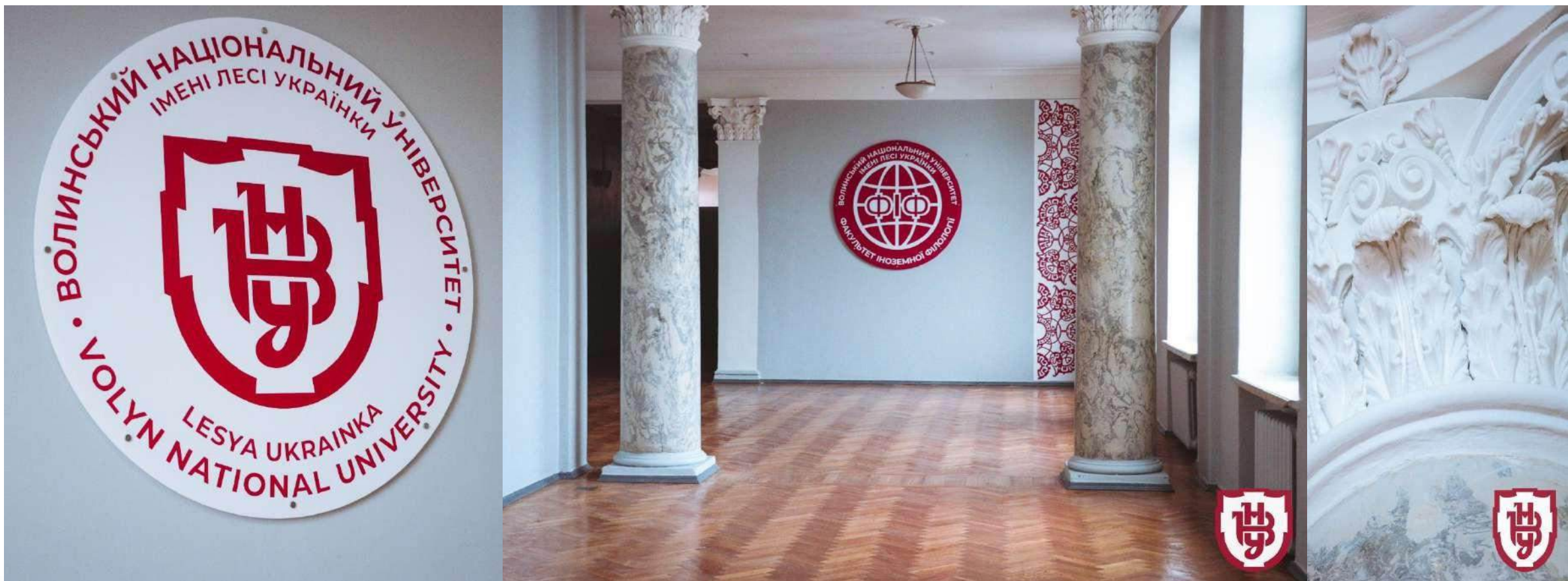
Economic activity, operation of facilities and infrastructure
